We at [Nature Reviews Chemistry](#) are inviting eminent authors to contribute to our journal, which has rapidly established itself as a high-impact forum for a broad and discerning community of connoisseurs and non-specialists alike. I am writing to ask if you have the time and interest to be a part of it all.

I have chosen to write to you in particular because of your expertise in electrochemical methods to studying catalytic mechanisms. A Perspective (up to ~3000 words, 5 display items) article can have a personal/historical/controversial tone. This format is rather short – we do hope they will be accessible to those out of a certain field, but still be of value to experts on the subject matter. You may also write in our longer Review format (up to ~7000 words, 8 display items) if you see that the topic justifies it. Such Review articles are a little more detailed and adopt a more formal tone than our Perspectives.

Please do let me know if you are interested in becoming a *Nat. Rev. Chem.* author, in which case I can send you more information. It would be awesome to have you on board to help bring the chemistry community up to date with what one can learn from electrochemistry, and how these lessons have important consequences in renewable energy catalysis.
